## NEW ENTRANT INFORMATION

### Welcome to St Patrick's School

Starting school is an exciting time for you and your child, and our aim is to make this a positive and happy experience.

### Pre School Visits

You will receive a letter following enrolment acceptance inviting you and your child to a school visit. Following this your child will have individual class sessions.

These sessions are usually held on a Tuesday from 9.30 –11am.

For the visits your child will need a schoolbag with a drink bottle of water and some morning tea. They don't need to wear school uniform.

Our New Entrant Teacher will visit your child at their pre –school so that the best possible school beginning is established.

The Pre School visits are for your child to get to know their teacher, and meet their classmates. They quickly learn to follow routines, and enjoy this positive experience.

While your child is attending these visits you may wish to call into the office and discuss school uniform and any other queries you may have.

Talk to your child about their first day and make sure they are feeling excited about school, even if there might be a few nerves!



## YOUR CHILD'S FIRST DAYS

Beginning school is an exciting and tiring time! We know that all children are different and some may need a couple of early finishes in their first few days.
