HELPING YOUR CHILD READ AT HOME

MAKE READING FUN:-

- All children like to **BE READ TO**, so don’t stop reading to them – no matter how old they are.

TAKE YOUR CHILD TO THE LIBRARY

- Help them to choose books to share. Find other books by the same author or on the same topic (or look for more information on the web- you might have to be the reader for this one).

HERE’S A HELPFUL TIP

- Help your child to link stories to their own life. Remind them about what they have done when a similar thing happens in the story.
