MEASLES OUTBREAK – PLEASE BE AWARE

The Ministry of Health is contacting all Hawkes Bay Schools to warn them of a measles epidemic that has hit New Zealand. So far 387 cases have been detected, the highest since 1997. Most cases have occurred in <u>unimmunized</u> people. This is a <u>highly infectious disease</u> and is more serious than many people realise. Symptoms includes – **fever, cough, red eyes** and a **runny nose** then a **rash** which develops around 3 days after the other symptoms start. **WHAT TO DO:**

- > Check your child has been immunized
- > See you doctor
- \triangleright Keep children home (5 7 days)
