BUS RUN - TAMATEA / TARADALE

Our Tamatea / Taradale bus runs are operated by Metro and are shared with Sacred Heart College. Phone Metro to enquire about the bus route (835 0590). We have been able to keep prices the same for the last **5 years** as we subsidize about 50% of this cost. <u>Term Pass is **\$80**</u>, <u>20 ride pass</u> is **\$30** and a <u>single trip</u> ticket is **\$2**.

These can be purchased from the school office. From next week, pupils who do not have a pass/ticket will not be able to use the bus. (Family concession available for three or more, ask at the office).

CONTACTING TEACHERS

Please make an appointment to see the teacher if you need to discuss anything in depth. **Teachers are not available for phone calls during class time, but a message can always be passed on from the office.** Children can be contacted or contact you (with permission from a teacher) through the school office.

SOCIAL SKILL FOR FEBRUARY

Each month the school will focus on a Social skill that is intended to develop Christian values.
