A MESSAGE FROM THE PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE

There have been 140 confirmed cases of Measles reported so far in NZ. If your child has had two doses of the MMR (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) immunisation they are protected.

The Ministry of Health is urging parents to:

- Check if your child has had two doses of the MMR immunisation.
- If your child only has a record of receiving one dose of MMR they should have another as soon as possible.
- If your child has no record of MMR immunisation they should have one dose now and a second dose four weeks later.
- Immunisation is FREE from your GP or Practise • Nurse.
