Our pie day was a hit! We sold over 200 pies. They were delicious!

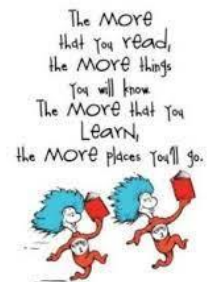
LEARNING CONFERENCES
